**FARRAJ (IRE)** (g. by Dubai Destination (USA)), won 6 races at 2 to 5 years, £395,052 including Winter Derby, Lingfield Park, **Gr.3**, Churchill Stakes, Lingfield Park, **L.**, second in Somerville Tattersall Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.3** and third in Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (c&g), Churchill Downs, **Gr.1**, Longines LKS Mackinnon Stakes, Flemington, **Gr.1**.

**KAREYMAH (GB)** (f. by Zafonic (USA)), won 3 races at 2 years at home and in France and £36,303 including Prix du Calvados, Deauville, **Gr.3** and Sweet Solera Stakes, Newmarket, **L.**

**Taqdeyr (GB)** (g. by Dubai Destination (USA)), won 4 races at 3 and 4 years and £38,033 and placed 5 times including third in Guisborough Stakes, Redcar, **L.**

**JATHAABEH (GB)**, won 2 races at 3 years and £22,600; dam of winners.

**MIJHAAR (GB)**, 2 races at 3 and 5 years and £68,455 including Braveheart Stakes, Hamilton Park, **L.**, placed 10 times including third in Wolferton Handicap, Ascot, **L.**

**PARK APPEAL**, Champion 2yr old filly in England and Ireland in 1984, won 5 races at 2 and 4 years at home and in U.S.A. including Cheveley Park Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.1**, Moyglare Stud Stakes, Curragh, **Gr.1**; Own sister to **NASHAMAA**;

dam of **nine winners** from 9 runners and 12 foals of racing age including-

**CAPE CROSS (IRE)**, won 5 races at 2 to 5 years including Lockinge Stakes, Newbury, **Gr.1**, Queen Anne Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.2**, Celebration Mile, Goodwood, **Gr.2**, placed third in Prix Jacques Le Marois, Deauville, **Gr.1**; champion sire.

**VINCENNES (GB)**, won 3 races at 3 years in France and in Germany including Kolner Herbst Stuten Meile, Cologne, **Gr.3** and Prix de Saint-Cyr, Chantilly, **L.**; dam of winners.

**GREAT BRITAIN (GB)**, won 2 races at 3 and 5 years at home and in U.A.E. including Al Quoz Sprint, Nad Al Sheba, **L.**, placed third in Wentworth Stakes, Windsor, **L.**; sire.

**PHOENIX PARK (GB)**, won 3 races at 4 and 6 years in France including Prix du Carrousel, ParisLongchamp, **L.**

**ARVOLA (GB)**, won 1 race at 3 years and placed twice; dam of winners.

**DIKTAT (GB)**, Champion older sprinter in Europe in 1999, 7 races at 3 and 4 years at home and in France including Haydock Park Sprint Cup, **Gr.1**, Prix Maurice de Gheest, Deauville, **Gr.1**, Jersey Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.3**, Criterion Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.3**, placed third in Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, ParisLongchamp, **Gr.1**; sire.

**RECITE (JPN)**, 1 race at 2 years; dam of **ONE SPIRIT (IRE)**, 2 races at 3 and 4 years including Owenstown Stud Whitehead Memorial Stakes, Naas, **L.**

**SHOEI MIZUKI (JPN)**, winner in Japan; grandam of **CROCOSMIA (JPN)**, won Ireland Trophy Fuchu Himba Stakes, Tokyo, **Gr.2**, placed second in Queen Elizabeth II Cup, Kyoto, **Gr.1** (3 times) and third in Victoria Mile, Tokyo, **Gr.1**.
